**ACTION TAKEN:**

On 12/07/12, at approximately 1330 hours, I was dispatched by the Troop C desk person to the Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickinson Street in the Town of Newtown regarding a school shooting.

Upon arrival I was assigned by Major Hyatt to be a liaison to the **01 02 03 12** family. **01 02 03 12** was a first grade student who was a victim in the school shooting. As a liaison I have been assigned to assist **01 02** biological parents **01 02 03 12**, with any assistance that they need. A request that the **01 02 03 12** family had was to retrieve **01 02 03 12** favorite **01 02 03 12**. This is the **01 02 03 12** that **01 02 03 12** wore to school the day of the shooting.

On 12/21/12, I met with **01 02 03 12** and turned over possession of One (1) box of personal property for **01 02 03 12**, from **01 02 03 12** first grade classroom, Room 8, at Sandy Hook Elementary School, as packaged by Connecticut State Police Detectives in the days following the incident. **01 02 03 12** signed for the belongings on a JD-CR-18, Inventory of Property Seized without a Search Warrant. (See attached JD-CR-18, Inventory of Property Seized without a Search Warrant form)

On 01/05/13, at approximately 1230 hours, Detective Van Ness #1431 from Western District Major Crime Squad contacted me on my cellular phone regarding **01 02 03 12**. Detective Van Ness informed me that she believes that **01 02 03 12** has been located. Detective Van Ness asked me if I could come to Troop A to retrieve **01 02 03 12** and then present it to the **01 02 03 12** family for identification.

Upon arrival at Troop A, I met with Detective Van Ness and Sergeant Pattberg. I obtained from Sergeant Pattberg a **01 02 03 12**,

I was able to locate a 01 02 03 12 lunch box which was believed to be 01 02 03 12.

On 01/05/13, at approximately 1430 hours, I met with 01 02 03 12 and showed her the 01 02 03 12 lunch box. 01 02 03 12 positively identified these belongings to be 01 02 03 12. I returned these items into the possession of 01 02 03 12. 01 02 03 signed for the belongings on an Inventory of Property Seized without a Search Warrant.
