DATE AND TIME OF INVESTIGATION: On Friday December 14, 2012 from 2000 hours to 0200 hours.

SUMMARY: That on the above listed time and date this writer was assigned to make a death notification to the family of **01 02 03 12**

ACTION TAKEN: That on Friday December 14, 2012 this writer was assigned to make an official notification of death to the **01 02 03 12** family following the multiple victim shooting at The Sandy Hook Elementary School.

At approximately 2400 hours this writer along with Angela Jackson (a victim services specialist with the Federal Bureau of Investigation), and Victoria Bosse (Social Worker) responded to **01 02 03 12**. Upon arrival we met with **01 02 03 12** the parents of victim **01 02 03 12** in the living room of their residence. At that point they were informed of a positive identification, of their son, **01 02 03 12**, and were officially informed of his death at 0100 hours on December 15, 2012. They were supplied with a packet of information concerning the rights of victims of crimes. A brief conversation then took place with Angela Jackson informing the **01 02 03 12** of services offered to them by the Federal Government. Victoria Bosse then spoke with the family concerning their general well being in the aftermath of this tragic event to ensure they were aware of services available to them to aid in their grief.

We then asked the **01 02 03 12** if there was anything further we could do to help them at that time. We offered what little comfort we could during this moment. **01 02 03 12** then shared a picture of **01 02 03 12** and **01 02 03 12** with us and reflected on his life and that **01 02 03 12**

. After this the **01 02 03 12** indicated they wanted to be alone with their family and we left the residence at 0130 hours.
