Action Taken: On Friday 12/14/12 at approximately 2030 hours, I was called in early for midnight shift and ordered to respond to Sandy Hook Elementary School, located at 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown to assist with a crime scene involving a shooting with multiple victims.

Upon my arrival, I responded to the Connecticut State Police Command Post, located at the Sandy Hook Volunteer Fire & Rescue Company, 18-20 Riverside Road, Newtown. I was assigned by Sgt. Huffcut #159 to assume the security post at the corner of Dickinson Drive and Riverside Road. I remained at this post until contacted to report to the Sandy Hook Volunteer Fire & Rescue Company for a death notification detail.

On Saturday 12/15/12 at approximately 0040 hours, I was assigned to give a formal death notification to the family of victim 01 02 03 12 was a student in Victoria Soto's first grade classroom and was pronounced deceased as a result of the shooting earlier in the day. I was given a victim services packet along with survivor benefits information with instructions to give it to the victim's next of kin. I responded to 01 02 03 12 the victim's home located at . Assigned to accompany me to provide the family with support, was Lila Coddington of the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DHMAS) and Fr. Jeffrey Coutre. We were advised the victim's parents were 01 02 03 12 I arrived on scene and was met by multiple family members at the address. I spoke with an unidentified male and asked for either us in. The unidentified male then went upstairs and brought both of them into the dining room to sit with Coddington, Coutre and I. I advised 01 02 03 12 was confirmed as one of the victims. 01 02 03 12 asked how she was identified. I explained investigators and the Medical Examiner's office confirmed her identification through class records, description and photographs. They both were provided with the victim service packet and survivor benefit packet. I explained to them that I would be willing to answer any questions they may have to the best of my ability but explained that it is an on going investigation handled by the Connecticut State Police Western District Major Crime Squad. I obtained information 01 02 03 12 to complete the Connecticut State Police Contact Report, SP-241-C and asked if I could assist them in anyway. 01 02 03 12 from THE UNDERSIGNED, AN INVESTIGATOR HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND SAYS THAT: I AM THE WRITER OF THE ATTACHED POLICE REPORT PERTAININGTO THIS INCIDENT NUMBER. 01 02 03 12 stated they already had family staying with them in the house and more family coming later in the day. **Control 01 02 03 12** were both provided with my cellular phone number along with contact information for Coddington, Fr. Couture, the Medical Examiner's office, Troop A, and the Sandy Hook Command Post. Additionally, Fr. Couture provided information for a funeral home in the area. Coddington further advised the family she would be back to "check in" with them in the morning to be of further assistance if they required it.

An Autopsy was later completed by Dr. Kanfer (ME Case #12-01020312). 01 02 03 wake and funeral were both private ceremonies held at 01 02 03 12
