This Officer was assigned by the Connecticut State Police to assist the **01 02 03 12** family whose daughter **01 02 03 12** was murdered the morning of December 14th, 2012 inside the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown Connecticut. As part of my duties to assist the family I was given the task of returning the child's belongings retrieved from inside the classroom to her mother and father. On 12/27/2012 I received that property from the Connecticut State Police Troop A, Southbury, CT. The items given to me were obtained by the State Police on December 18th, 2012 during the course of their investigation. (case No. 12-00704559)

I advised the **01 02 03 12** family that I had possession of their daughter's personal belongings and offered to give it to them. Given the situation, the **01 02 03 12** family told me they were not ready to receive the items and requested I hold on to it for them until the time was right. I agreed and secured the belongings. I am currently awaiting further direction from the family at this time.
