----Family Meeting Report----

01 02 03 12

Action Taken: On 1/29/13, this Detective, as well as Detectives Mudry #824, Peters #816, Downs #502, Jewiss #336, and Officer Silver of the Newtown Police Department, responded to 12 Dickinson Drive, Sandy Hook, CT, for a prearranged meeting with 01 02 03 12. Also present was 01 02 03 12 and FBI Victim Services Specialist Ashley Hall.

01 02 03 12 had been present during the Group Informational Family Meeting that had been held on 1/15/13, and was aware of or had already received the following:

- Some background history of the shooter and his family
- Office of Victim Services Benefits Letter
- Family Support Form
- Timeline of Events
- Family Related Services Packet

01 02 03 12 was provided with the following information:

THE UNDERSIGNED, AN INVESTIGATOR HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND SAYS THAT: I AM THE WRITER OF THE ATTACHED POLICE REPORT PERTAINING TO THIS INCIDENT NUMBER. THAT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN WAS SECURED AS A RESULT OF (1) MY PERSONAL OBSERVATION AND KNOWLEDGE; OR (2) INFORMATION RELAYED TO ME BY OTHER MEMBERS OF MY POLICE DEPARTMENT OR OF ANOTHER POLICE DEPARTMENT; OR (3) INFORMATION SECURED BY MYSELF OR ANOTHER MEMBER OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE PERSON OR PERSONS NAMED OR IDENTIFIED THEREIN, AS INDICATED IN THE ATTACHED REPORT. 01 02 03 12 was asked if he knew where 01 02 03 12 desk was in the classroom and he stated that he recalled where one of 01 02 03 12 desks had been, but was unsure if it was the last spot he sat or not. 01 02 03 12 indicated on the map that he believed that 01 02 03 12 desk may have been right in front of where his body was found in the classroom, but could not provide a solid answer.

01 02 03 12 asked to see the neighboring classrooms, as well as some of the other classrooms in the building that he felt were connected to his son, such as 01 02 03 12 former kindergarten classroom, as well as a corner classroom at the end of the front hallway where 01 02 03 12 would pick his son up each afternoon.

01 02 03 12 was advised that 01 02 03 12 jacket 01 02 03 12, was identified via photograph by 01 02 03 12 as belonging to 01 02 03 12 was released to 01 02 03 12 on 1/15/13.

On 2/12/13, this Detective responded to 12 Dickinson Drive, Sandy Hook, CT, and met with Newtown Police Officer Jeff Silver, as well as 01 02 03 12, as arranged by this Detective at the request of 01 02 03 12 and 01 02 03 12 were afforded time within 01 02 03 12 classroom a 01 02 03 12 request. Prior to leaving the school, 01 02 03 12 stated that he would make himself available to assist with the families involved in the investigation in any way needed.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
