**ACTION TAKEN:**

On 12/20/12 at approximately 1400 hours I was advised by the State Police Command Post in Newtown to report to the Sandy Hook Elementary School to receive the property of **01 02 03 12** and return it to the **01 02 03 12** family. I contacted **01 02 03 12**, via telephone and I advised her that I was going to return **01 02 03 12** property to her if she wanted it. **01 02 03 12** said she was eagerly awaiting the items and that she and **01 02 03 12** would be home to receive the items. At the Sandy Hook Elementary School I met with Sgt DeCesare from the Major Crimes Unit and he turned over to me two cardboard bankers boxes labeled **01 02 03 12**. I took the boxes and I transported them in my cruiser to **01 02 03 12**. At the residence I met with **01 02 03 12** took custody of the boxes and signed the JD CR-18. I returned the JD CR-18 to Sgt DeCesare of the Major Crimes Unit at the Sandy Hook Elementary School.
