Chris Allegro.

With the property having been returned to the [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 my involvement in this matter will be concluded.

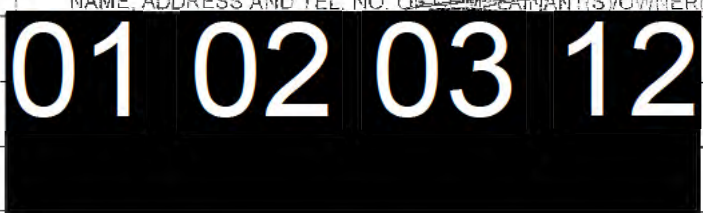
