ACTION TAKEN: On Friday December 21, 2012 I was assigned by Sgt. DeCesare, Troop G Major Crime Supervisor, to pick up and return what has been identified as the personal property of 01 02 03 12, a student at Sandy Hook Elementary School.

I transported both 01 02 03 12 property to the 01 02 03 12 home located at 01 02 03 12. Upon arrival, I met with 01 02 03 12 and brought all the property into the home. 01 02 03 12 signed the JD-CR-18's and took possession of both 01 02 03 12 property. See attached JD-CR-18.

Once the property had been signed for, I left the residence and returned to Sandy Hook Elementary School and turned the signed JD-CR-18's over to Det. Chris Allegro.

With the property having been returned over to the 01 02 for safekeeping, my involvement in this matter will be concluded.
