This Detective contacted Detective Karoline Keith #533 regarding 01 02 03 12 clothing seized from the scene, and learned that the jacket described by was not included in 01 02 03 12 property.

This Detective spoke with Detective Allegro #950 about the process associated with packing up the decedent's belongings and was advised that in one of the two classrooms many of the jackets were stored inside the backpacks due to a lack of space in the classroom, and that it was possible that the jacket was in 01 02 03 12 book bag, but that the description of the jacket is not one that he is familiar with having seen. Detective Allegro advised that when he and several other State Police Detectives took over the process of handling the decedent's property within the classrooms, much of the property that was determined to be not salvageable had already been removed, and that he and the other Detectives cleaned what they could and went as far as to cut away any contaminated edges or corners on the children's art or school work so that it could be boxed up and returned to the


