SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT: S.H.E.S. Student Accountability

ACTION TAKEN: On Friday December 14th, 2012, while at the Sandy Hook Fire Department (Command Post), this Detective assisted Major Warren Hyatt #014 in compiling a comprehensive list of students who were currently assigned to 1st Grade Classrooms at the Sandy Hook Elementary School, more specifically, Classrooms #8 (D'Amato) and #10 (Soto).

This Detective was able to obtain a copy of the student / classroom roster and subsequently cross-referenced it against Major Hyatt's preliminary list of student victims. In doing so, this Detective identified the following five (5) students: [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] as being unaccounted for. At which point, Major Hyatt tasked this Detective to go to each of the student's residence in an attempt to physically locate them.

At approximately 1845 hours, this Detective accompanied by WDMCS Detective Rachael Van Ness #1431 and Newtown Police Youth Officer Gladys Pisani, arrived at the first residence [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED]. Upon arrival, this Detective was greeted by [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] the father of [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED]. This Detective identified himself and advised [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] as to the reason for his visit. [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] was safe and then called for her to come meet / speak briefly with this Detective ---> STUDENT ACCOUNTED FOR.

At approximately 1910 hours, this Detective accompanied by WDMCS Detective Rachael Van Ness #1431 and Newtown Police Youth Officer Gladys Pisani, arrived at the second residence [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED]. Upon arrival, this Detective was greeted by [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED], the parents of [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED]. This Detective identified himself and advised [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 [REDACTED] as to the

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reason for his visit. 01 02 03 12 reported 01 02 03 12 was safe and then called for him to come meet / speak briefly with this Detective ---> STUDENT ACCOUNTED FOR.

At approximately 1930 hours, this Detective accompanied by WDMCS Detective Rachael Van Ness #1431 and Newtown Police Youth Officer Gladys Pisani, arrived at the third residence 01 02 03 12 Upon arrival, this Detective was greeted by 01 02 03 12 This Detective identified himself and advised 01 02 03 12 as to the reason for his visit. 01 02 03 12 reported 01 02 03 12 was safe and then called for her to come meet / speak briefly with this Detective ---> STUDENT ACCOUNTED FOR.

While en route to the fourth residence 01 02 03 12, this Detective spoke with WDMCS Supervisor, Sergeant Michael DeCesare #205, via phone. This Detective was subsequently informed by Sgt. DeCesare that he had interviewed 01 02 03 12 at the Newtown Police Department earlier in the day and that 01 02 03 12 was safe and with his parents ---> STUDENT ACCOUNTED FOR.

At approximately 1945 hours, this Detective accompanied by WDMCS Detective Rachael Van Ness #1431 and Newtown Police Youth Officer Gladys Pisani, arrived at the fifth residence 01 02 03 12 Upon arrival, this Detective found no one present at the residence and the entire property (interior / exterior) was in complete darkness. At which point, Detective Van Ness placed a telephone call to the 01 02 03 12 Family and left a voicemail message requesting a return call.

No return call was ever received that evening from the 01 02 03 12 Family, however, it was quickly learned through other student's parents as well as various WDMCS personnel that 01 02 03 12 was safe and had been picked up earlier in the day at the Newtown Police Department by his parents ---> STUDENT ACCOUNTED FOR.
