Newtown Board of Ed. Letter Regarding Victim's Property

## Action Taken:

During the course of this investigation it was learned that the Newtown Board of Education was in possession of some of the victim's personal items from Sandy Hook Elementary School. The WDMC was unaware of this and asked that they, specifically Superintendent Janet Robinson, compile a list of items in possession of the Board of Ed. so WDMC detectives could notify the families of the recovered property.

On 03/11/13, I spoke with Dr. Robinson's secretary Kathy June who stated that the Newtown Board Of Ed. did not have any further items in their possession to return to the victim's families. On 04/02/13, at my request, Dr. Robinson followed -up my request with a letter reiterating such. (See attached).
