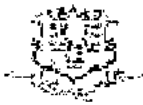

Information pertaining to the pending release of several search and seizure warrants was discussed and the families were advised that at midnight the warrants would be made public.

The families relayed some of the concerns that the mounting Freedom of Information requests were bringing regarding the release of information or photos pertaining to their loved ones.

Additional information and facts pertaining to the investigation were verbally provided.

There were several questions asked and answered by the friends and family members and Lt. DelVecchia prior to the completion of the meeting.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
