----Family Meeting Report----

01 02 03 12

Action Taken: On 4/18/13, this Detective met with **01 02 03 12** mother of Sandy Hook Elementary shooting victim **01 02 03 12** at the Newtown Middle School, Newtown, CT, at which time a piece of artwork belonging to **01 02 03 12** was returned to **01 02 03 12** requested a visit to the school for the following day, if possible, as she was in CT only overnight and felt she was ready to go to the school if possible.

On 4/19/13, this Detective, Newtown Police Officer Jeff Silver and Detective Peters #816 met with **01 02 03 12** at 12 Dickinson Drive, Sandy Hook, CT, for a prearranged school visit.

01 02 03 12 was not present for either of the Group Family Meetings, although she has been kept apprised of investigative information through her assigned Trooper Liaison, **01 02**. Detective Peters and this Detective subsequently provided her, in part, with the following information:

- a basic review of the timeline of events (dated 1/15/13)
- general location of where **01 02 03 12** body was found
- some general background information about the shooter and his family

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01 02 03 12 agreed that it was fine to release 01 02 03 12 location to the family members of the other deceased victims. 01 02 03 12 was advised of some information pertaining to verbalizations from the shooter, and was also advised that there was not yet a sequence of rooms determined for the shooting in the two first grade classrooms 01 02 03 12 was offered some specific information to questions she had about the shooter's entry to the school and the amount of shots fired in various areas, as well as the condition of and remaining ammunition in the magazines found in the school. Some of the inaccurate information that had been put out in the media was clarified, and 01 02 03 12 was provided with accurate details pertaining to the inaccurate information put out by a member of the State Police command staff at a conference in New Orleans. The information that this Detective had been given permission to release pertaining to the location of the teachers and some students within Room 8 was also provided to 01 02 03 12 and some inaccurate details regarding where she had heard that students' bodies were found in the classroom were dispelled.

01 02 03 12 was afforded some time to reflect privately within the classroom prior to clearing the school.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.

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
