A moment of silence in memory of those lost in the tragedy at Sandy Hook Elementary was held.

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Information pertaining to autopsy reports and contact information for Dr. Wayne Carver at the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner's Office was relayed.

There was discussion amongst those present pertaining to upcoming visits for surviving student family members as well as staff and faculty. The family members that expressed their opinions regarding the upcoming visits overwhelmingly advised that they have no issue with those that were present at the school on 12/14/12 visiting the school in the near future, as long as there are strict rules enforced regarding those that are given access to the locked hallway where the shooting occurred. The decedent families expressed that they have no issue with parents or a teacher assigned to their child's classroom being afforded the opportunity to visit that particular classroom, but did not wish for those parents or that teacher to have access to the other classroom, meaning the parents of the Room 10 survivors will be given access to Room 10 only, and the Room 8 survivor parents and teacher will be given access to Room 8 only. The families also advised that they do not feel that any other parties, regardless of what commission or party they are representing, need to have access to the hallway or classrooms where the shooting took place.

The families reiterated some of their concerns pertaining to Freedom of Information requests and heard from SA Sedensky regarding the bill proposal he has sent up to the Legislature.

Additional information and facts pertaining to the investigation were verbally provided.

There were several questions asked and answered by the friends and family members and Lt. DeVecchia prior to the completion of the meeting.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.

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
