**Family Meeting Report
(The 01 02 03 12 Family- 2/7/13)**

Action Taken:

On 2/7/13, this Detective and Detective Jewiss #336 responded to the 01 02 03 12 residence for a prearranged meeting to discuss details of the ongoing investigation. Present for this meeting were the following persons:

01 02 03 12
01 02 (Family Liaison Trooper)

The 01 02 03 12 had not been present for the Group Family Meeting held on 1/15/13 because they were out of state, but had already received much of the information that had been learned through the investigative process through their liaison or via telephone conversations with Detectives. Detective Jewiss and I subsequently provided the 01 02 03 12 with the following information:

- a timeline of events (dated 1/15/13)
- an estimated timeline for the return of 01 02 03 12 remaining personal property
- answers to some questions specific to 01 02 03 12 and what had been learned about where she was in her classroom

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- answers were also provided to a series of questions that had been forwarded to this Detective in advance of the meeting by the family
- answers to questions regarding some specific questions pertaining to the weapons and ammunition owned and used in the shooting
- answers to questions regarding whether or not the public will be allowed access to the shooter's mental health records
- answers to questions regarding the knowledge that the substitute teacher would have of the school
- clarification regarding the persons that were taken into custody on 12/14, and discussion regarding an aerial video they had seen on television
- information regarding the autopsy reports, specifically as to when they will be available and any items of evidence seized at autopsy
- information regarding some statements potentially made by the shooter while in the school
- answers as to whether or not there was an autopsy on the shooter and what ultimately was learned or might be learned from it

Detectives engaged in discussion regarding when they believe the investigation might be concluded and the reports will be available to the public, as well as conversation regarding the Freedom of Information requests that have been received.

The 01 02 03 12 discussed a negative experience that they had with a particular Trooper at the firehouse on 12/14, and further relayed details of their negative experiences of being at the firehouse and being given inconsistent information, the poorly done mass death notification, the stall tactics that they felt were being utilized to delay notification.

The 01 02 03 12 consented to allow Detectives to disclose 01 02 03 12 location within her classroom to the other decedent and victim families.

Several rumors that the 01 02 03 12 had heard were dispelled by Detectives during the meeting.

The 01 02 03 12 also posed several questions that could not be answered at the time, to include:

- what the fate of the school would be
- what would happen to the shooter's residence
- where the other children were in relation to their daughter
- what the path of the shooter was once inside the school

The 01 02 03 12 were advised that as those answers became available for release they would be advised of the information.

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The status of the case remains actively under investigation.

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
