Family Meeting Report

(04 [REDACTED] of Lauren Rousseau- 1/24/13)

Action Taken:

On 1/24/13, this Detective and Detective Jewiss #336 responded to 04 [REDACTED] CT, for a prearranged private meeting with 04 [REDACTED] Lauren Rousseau. Upon arrival, this Detective was advised that despite having been invited to attend, that Lauren's 04 [REDACTED] had chosen not to attend due to the fact that they believed that the 04 [REDACTED] might want to know more information than they are comfortable knowing at this time. Present for the meeting were the following persons:

Additionally, Lauren has a 04 [REDACTED], who currently resides in 04 [REDACTED] and could not be present for the meeting.

04 [REDACTED] had not been present at the Group Family Meeting on 1/15/13, and therefore had not yet received much of the information provided by the State Police during that meeting.

04 [REDACTED] inquired about where Lauren's car had been parked in the school lot, as it had been struck multiple times by bullets believed to have passed through the front windows of the school, and asked if Lauren's had been the only car struck.

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04 [redacted] were provided with the following information:

- the location of Lauren inside her classroom
- timeline of events (dated 1/15/13)
- some background history of the shooter and information pertaining to the weapons owned by the family and carried on his person or in his vehicle that day
- information received from the surviving victims and teachers regarding what they recalled from the classrooms that day
- family support form
- office of victim services benefits letter (dated 1/15/13)
- family related services packet (dated 1/14/13)
- I.R.S. SSN Protection Memo

04 [redacted] advised that when the death notification was done to them, it was done poorly with the wrong information, and that they had Lauren's date of birth wrong and thought that she was 04 [redacted], but cited that they did not believe it was the fault of the Trooper assigned to complete the task, rather the fault of whomever gave him the information. 04 [redacted] further stated that their initial liaison Trooper lived so far away that she had been sent home and therefore was not the one assigned to make the notification, despite the fact that they had already formed a connection to her. 04 [redacted] believed that having Troopers from so far away interfered with their ability to provide proper support to the family.

04 [redacted] indicated that they did not believe that they would like to have Lauren's clothing returned to them, and stated that they had given her jacket to her best friend after it was returned to them.

04 [redacted] indicated that at this time they did not wish to schedule a walk-through of the school.

04 [redacted] consented to allowing other decedent and victim family members to know where Lauren was inside the classroom.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
