-School Visit Report-

01 02 03 12

Action Taken: On 4/30/13 at approximately 1000 hours, this Detective, Newtown Police Officer Jeff Silver and Detective Jewiss #336, responded to Sandy Hook Elementary School, 12 Dickinson Drive, Sandy Hook, for a prearranged school visit with 01 02 03 12

Both 01 02 03 12 had been present at all of the informational group family meetings that have been held and therefore had already received all of the investigative information that had been given to the decedents' families. 01 02 03 12 had also had two private meetings with Detectives regarding details of the incident and the ongoing investigation, and were relaying the information to 01 02 03 12 as she requested it. 01 02 03 12 were given the opportunity to walk through the impacted areas within the school and were provided, in part, with the following information:

- a basic review of the timeline (dated 1/15/13)
- details specific to 01 02 03 12 as relayed by the surviving children from Classroom 10
- information regarding the Medical Examiner's reports and how to obtain them
- information regarding where 01 02 03 12 desk was in the classroom at the time of the incident
- clarification of some misinformation and rumors that had circulated within the media outlets
- information regarding 01 02 03 12 proximity to other victims within the classroom, as permitted by the decedents' families
