-School Visit Report-

01 02 03 12 Family

Action Taken: On 8/16/13, this Detective, Detective Mudry #824 and Newtown Police Officer Jeff Silver responded to the Sandy Hook Elementary School, 12 Dickinson Drive, Sandy Hook, CT, for a prearranged school visit with [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 had been present for some of the informational group family meetings held for the decedents' families, and therefore had already received some of the investigative information that had been put out by the State Police. 01 02 03 were provided with, in part, the following information:

- information specific to [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 and his location within the classroom
- information regarding [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 proximity to the other child victims, as permitted by the decedents' families
- information regarding the location of the adult victims, as permitted by their families
- information regarding the number of shell casings found in various areas within the impacted spaces
- information regarding the shooter's physical appearance and his wearing of earplugs
- information regarding where the shooter had parked his vehicle and some items found near it
- information regarding what was identified and relayed to bolster the theory that there was a second shooter
- a review of the updated timeline which includes times and information, in part, from radio transmissions, 911 calls, in-car cameras and statements
- information regarding where the shooter's body was found
- information regarding what the surviving children said and reported hearing
- clarification of misinformation that circulated in the media
- information regarding the locks on the doors and which doors were and were not locked

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- information regarding what occurred in Classroom 12 (Roig)
- information regarding some verbalizations that were overheard and are believed to have been made by the shooter and/or students
- clarifying information regarding the persons within Conference Room #9, their actions and the engagement of the school intercom system

**01 02 03 12** were given the opportunity to access the impacted areas within the school and some additional questions were asked and answered prior to clearing the school.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
