On December 17, 2012 at 1000 hours, this Trooper along with Lieutenant Delvecchia went to Room 10 of the Sandy Hook Elementary School, This is the classroom where 01 02 03 12 was a first grade student in Amanda D'Amato's class. This Trooper located 01 02 03 12 01 02 03 12 hanging on a hook in her assigned coat rack spot. Inside her backpack was an 01 02 03 12 01 02 03 12 All the items were taken for safe keeping and brought back to residence. The items were returned to 01 02 03 12 at 1400 hours on December 17, 2012.
