**Action Taken:**

This Trooper is assigned as the Family Liaison to the family of [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 who is a victim of the Sandy Hook Elementary School Shooting.

On December 16, 2012 at 2200 hours, this Trooper received a request from [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 about having their daughter's personal items returned to them. This Trooper spoke with Connecticut State Police Lieutenant David Delvecchia who agreed to release [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 personal items which were located in her classroom.

On December 17, 2012 at 1000 hours, this Trooper along with Lieutenant Delvecchia went to Room 10 of the Sandy Hook Elementary School. This is the classroom where [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 was a first grade student in Amanda D'Amato's class. This Trooper located [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 hanging on a hook in her assigned coat rack spot. Inside her backpack was an [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12

All the items were taken for safe keeping and brought back to [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 residence. The items were returned to [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 at 1400 hours on December 17, 2012.

On December 18, 2012 at 1100 hours, this Trooper received a phone call from Connecticut State Police Sergeant Eric Dency. Dency stated he had located [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 lunch box inside the Sandy Hook Elementary School. This Trooper took possession of the lunch box and secured it for [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12
