Action Taken: Upon review of a summary of EMS responders that had been provided to CSP Detectives in the days following the shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary, this Detective observed that it had been relayed that Newtown EMS Unit A2, occupied by Marty Folan and John Burke, in addition to Paramedic 5D2 Robert Velletri had transported one juvenile female patient, identified as "Jane Doe" to Danbury Hospital on 12/14/12.

This Detective contacted the dispatch for the aforementioned EMS crew and clarified that only one juvenile female patient, **01 02 03 12** had been transported via ambulance, and that this Detective had taken a sworn written statement pertaining to the transport from AEMT Cathryn Dahlmeyer, whom is not identified as having been on the ambulance with **01 02 03 12**

This Detective was advised that after a database and records check, that AEMT Dahlmeyer was the fourth member of the crew, and had been accidentally omitted from the list given to CSP, but that Dahlmeyer was in the ambulance that transported **01 02 03 12**

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
