Action Taken: On 3/1/13, members of the Western District Major Crime Squad held an informational meeting with the teachers and staff of the Sandy Hook Elementary School at the new S.H.E.S., formerly Chalk Hill School, located in Monroe, CT. The aforementioned meeting was also attended by several family members that had been invited by staff or faculty, as well as by Captain Rios and Chief Kehoe of the Newtown Police Department, several Monroe Police Department Officers, and current S.H.E.S. administrative staff members.

A sign-in attendance sheet was prepared for all those present (see attached).

Those in attendance were provided with factual information about the incident on 12/14/12, inclusive of a basic timeline of known movement or actions associated with the shooter, responders or witnesses.

A question and answer segment was held at the end of the briefing in an effort to clarify any misinformation that still existed and could be corrected at that time.

Several staff and faculty members have asked to return to the school in the future for closure purposes and were advised that their request would be facilitated at a later date, as the priority for school visits at this point in the investigation is for the families of the deceased victims.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
