Explanation of Federal Reports

Beginning on December 14, 2012, several federal agencies, including but not limited to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, the United States Marshal Service and the United States Attorney's Office, assisted the State Police with this investigation. The assistance included: (1) conducting witness interviews, e.g., family members, neighborhood residents and individuals with whom the shooter communicated electronically; (2) the collection and analysis of documentary evidence related to the shooter and Nancy Lanza, e.g., financial records, medical records, educational records, documentation regarding deliveries made to the Lanza residence and items obtained during searches conducted at Lanza family residences, (3) the forensic review of electronic evidence, e.g., blog sites visited by and email accounts associated with the Lanza family and (4) interviews of individuals who claimed, albeit falsely, to have information regarding the incident.

After reports were completed by members of the each federal agency they were supplied to the State Police in their entirety for inclusion within our investigation. However, while the State Police were in possession of federal reports and were permitted to review the reports in their entirety, they were not permitted to retain un-redacted copies of the reports due to federal law restrictions. Accordingly, many State Police reports that would otherwise include a federal investigative report as an attachment are now without such attachment. Per the State Police Legal Affairs Office, the wording "Note: All Federal documents and information were returned to the FBI pursuant to its request" was added to the affected reports. The redacted federal reports were incorporated into the State Police case file by Detective Downs.

As of August of 2013, members of the State Police and the State's Attorney's Office including, but not limited to Major Hyatt (BCI), Lt. DeVecchia (WDMC), Sgt. Pattberg (WDMC), Det. Combes (WDMC), Det. Allegro (WDMC), Det. Flynn (WDMC), Det. Soares (CDMC), Det. Bennett (EDMC), Inspector Mahoney and State's Attorney Sedensky from the Danbury State's Attorney's Office reviewed all known FBI reports with the assistance of

Furthermore, there is no evidence that the shooter ever communicated to anyone that he intended to commit murder or any other crime of violence.


Dear Mr. Sedensky:

During the investigation of the Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting, the FBI primarily assisted with the collection and analysis of evidence and the interviews of witnesses and family members. To date, based on the evidence collected and reviewed, it is our belief that Adam Lanza acted without the assistance of any co-conspirators and/or accessories. Furthermore, we found no evidence that Lanza ever communicated to anyone that he intended to commit murder or any other crime of violence.

As you know, attempts are still underway to recover some forensic evidence. It is anticipated that this may take several months.

Although no words or actions can reverse the horrific events of December 14, 2012, on behalf of the FBI, I want to thank you and your colleagues for your professionalism and tireless efforts during this enormous tragedy.
