**EXHIBIT REPORT: NEWTOWN HIGH SCHOOL**

On Monday, January 7, 2013 at approximately 1100 hours, Newtown High School SRO Jason Flynn signed a Consent to Search and Examine Evidence (DPS-167-C). The consent was given in order to download video surveillance from the high school's camera system. State of Connecticut Forensic Science Examiner, Lucinda Lopes was also at the high school attempting to download the video. During the downloading procedure issues were encountered, therefore the best course of action was to seize the Compaq computer tower, keyboard and mouse from the SRO and to bring it to the State of Connecticut Laboratory in Meriden for downloading.

On Thursday, 1/10/13 at approximately 0943 hours I retained possession of the Compaq computer tower, keyboard, mouse and four copies of the downloaded video surveillance from the State of Connecticut Laboratory.

On 1/10/13 at approximately 1300 hours I transported the Compaq computer tower, keyboard and mouse to Newtown High School and returned the items to SRO Jason Flynn.

On 1/10/13 I secured one Western Digital My Passport 500GB and cable into Troop A evidence.
