Action Taken: On 12/28/12, this Detective was assigned by Sgt. Pattberg #130, to respond to the Sandy Hook Elementary School and assist Detective Insalaco #748 with seizing a section of carpeting from Room #10.

It was explained to this Detective that blood within the aforementioned carpet was going to be used as a known blood sample from the shooter.


Upon arrival at S.H.E.S., this Detective assisted Detective Insalaco while he cut out and peeled up a section of carpeting from the floor in Miss Soto's 1st grade classroom just inside the main door. The aforementioned carpet sample was cut from within a large blood soaked area where the body of the shooter, Adam Lanza, had been discovered after shooting himself in the head.

At 1209 hours, Detective Insalaco and this Detective packaged the seized sample of carpet within a medium sized envelope, and then packaged the medium sized envelope within a larger envelope, which was then sealed with evidence tape per CSP protocol.

This Detective transported the item to Troop A, Southbury, where it was identified and labeled as Exhibit #341. Exhibit #341 was placed into WDMC temporary evidence holding until it was submitted into evidence on 1/2/13 @ approximately 1130 hours (see attached JD-CR-18.)
