On December 15, 2012, I was assigned by Sgt. Pattberg to follow up on video surveillance seized by Det. LaCluyze and Det. Gogluicci. I was informed that these detectives seized video surveillance (Exhibit #50) from Tony Tomassi who is a Loss Prevention employee for Dick's Sporting Goods in Danbury, Connecticut.

I was informed that Mr. Tomassi had additional video of the same individuals at the gun case at Dick's Sporting Goods in Danbury, Connecticut on 12/11/12. I was given a copy of the original lead sheet and asked to follow up on the additional video.

On December 15, 2012 at 1101 hours I met with Mr. Tomassi at Dick's Sporting Goods located at 470 Lewis Ave in Meriden, Connecticut. Mr. Tomassi showed me the additional video he captured and saved to a thumb drive labeled "San Disk Cruzer Glide 8GB." Tomassi supplied me with a yellow lined sheet of paper titled "Dick's Sporting Goods #612 Danbury, CT 12/11/12." Tomassi also pointed out seven listed times corresponding with the video surveillance he captured on the thumb drive. Tomassi showed me the video surveillance which depicted the individuals entering and exiting the store, as well as going to and from the gun counter. Tomassi also provided me with nine captured video stills, depicting three individuals that are in the video surveillance.

On December 15, 2012 at 1155 hours I seized the thumb drive labeled "San Disk Cruzer Glide 8GB" from Tomassi. I transported the thumb drive to the Western District Major Crime Van which was at the scene. There I met with Det. Sliby who was in charge of evidence. At 1300 hours I handed over the evidence over to Det. Sliby who assigned the thumb drive exhibit #52.

Attached to the report is the following: the original Inventory of Property Seized Without a Search Warrant (JD-CR-18) filled out by this Detective, my rough notes listed on the original Lead sheet (SP-241-C) and the nine captured video pictures from the surveillance. It must be noted that no

On May 13, 2013 at 1000 hours Det. Kimball reviewed the nine captured video stills depicting the three individuals in the video surveillance. Det. Kimball determined that none of the individuals appear to be either Ryan or Adam Lanza. Det. Kimball also stated that he saw his witness, 04 depicted in two of the nine photos, specifically at the gun counter.
