

And the facts establishing the grounds for issuing a Search and Seizure Warrant are the following:

- 1. That the affiant Detective Matthew E LaCluyze, #0548 is a regular swom member of the Connecticut State Police Department and has been a member of said Department for the past 10 years having participated in numerous criminal investigations, which have led to arrests and convictions. That the affiant LaCluyze is presently assigned to the State Police Central District Major Crime Squad.
- 2. That the affiant Detective James Nolting, #1022 is a regular sworn member of the Connecticut State Police Department and has been a member of said Department for the past 7 years having participated in numerous criminal investigations, which have led to arrests and convictions. That the affiant Nolting is presently assigned to the State Police Central District Major Crime Squad.
- 3. That on Friday, 12/14/12, at approximately 0935 hours, Newtown Police Department received a 911 call from a caller at the Sandy Hook Elementary School, 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown, CT. The caller reported that an active shooting situation was occurring at the Sandy Hook Elementary School.
