Exhibit Report (Hard Drive) # 374

On August 2, 2013 members of the Western District Major Crime Squad (WDMCS) received a Western Digital 320GB hard drive bearing serial number 000001D919A0 from the FBI. This drive contained forensic image files of certain pieces of electronic evidence seized from 36 Yogananda Street in Newtown, CT by members of the Connecticut State Police (CSP) pursuant to a search and seizure warrant. The CSP exhibits had been turned over to the FBI where the contents of each item were forensically imaged onto the Western Digital hard drive for further examination and analysis. The CSP Exhibits imaged onto this drive are Exhibits # 4, # 24, # 31 and # 44 (seized under case # CFS-12-00705354) and Exhibits # 601 and # 602A (seized under CFS-12-00704559). This hard drive was then placed into an I/O Magic USB Enclosure to allow the imaged files to be viewed.

This Western Digital hard drive with I/O Magic USB Enclosure was assigned Exhibit # 374 under case number CFS-12-00704559. Five of the six forensic image files were reviewed by members of the Western District Major Crime Squad at the request of State's Attorney Stephen Sedensky to determine if there were any items of evidentiary value located in them. The results of that review are detailed in a separate report titled "Review of Electronic Evidence." The Western Digital drive was then submitted to the Connecticut State Police Forensic Science Laboratory Computer Crimes & Electronic Evidence section on 09/25/13 because the remaining forensic image file was unable to be viewed using the equipment/software available to WDMCS detectives. A separate report detailing the findings from the examination of that image file will be forthcoming from the Computer Crimes & Electronic Evidence section.
