Date and Time of Investigation:

Friday, December 14th, 2012 at approximately 1300 hours.

**Summary of Incident:**

On the above mentioned date and time members of the Statewide Narcotics Task Force Northwest Office responded to the scene of Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown Connecticut on a report of an active shooter within the school. This writer interviewed several witnesses in which written statements were taken.

**ACTION TAKEN:**

On Friday December 14th, 2012 between 1300 and 1318 hours, this writer assisted [REDACTED] 04 with a written statement she had provided. [REDACTED] 04 is a teacher at the school and a summary of her statement is as follows:

[REDACTED] 04 explained that she is a [REDACTED] 04 teacher in classroom [REDACTED] 04 and was in her classroom with her students at the time of the incident. She stated she heard gun shots and began lockdown procedures. [REDACTED] 04 locked the classroom door and covered the windows. The children got onto the floor and she pulled the desks to block the children. She went on to explain that she heard gunshots and yelling over the loudspeaker. She heard yelling outside the classroom about a gun and saw two police officers walk by the door. She and her students stayed in the classroom until they were escorted out of the school by the police.
