Interview and Witness Statement of [REDACTED] 04

ACTION TAKEN: On Friday, December 14, 2012, at approximately 1155 hours, I interviewed [REDACTED] 04, [REDACTED] at the Sandy Hook Fire Department regarding his observations involving a shooting incident which had taken place at approximately 0930 hours at the Sandy Hook Elementary School, 21 Dickinson Drive, Newtown, CT. [REDACTED] 04 and was present inside the school when the incident began. [REDACTED] 04 later provided a one-page handwritten witness statement, written in his own words, as well as a hand drawn sketch map (on statement page 1) of his approximate location in the school when the incident began, and the approximate location where he exited the building while the incident was occurring. [REDACTED] 04 provided the following information:

[REDACTED] 04 stated that when he arrived at Sandy Hook Elementary School on the morning of Friday, December 14, 2012, he parked his vehicle, CT passenger registration [REDACTED] 04, in the front row closest to the school parking lot, toward the right/center if facing the school. [REDACTED] 04 stated that at approximately 9:30AM, he was in a "meeting room" (west side of school) with three other female teachers; [REDACTED] 04. Shortly thereafter, [REDACTED] 04 began to hear what appeared to be gunshots coming from somewhere in the hallway outside of the meeting room. [REDACTED] 04 said he then began to hear the sound of the gunshots being broadcast over the school's intercom/loud speaker. [REDACTED] 04 and the three female teachers attempted to hide within the meeting room that they were in because they knew the door to their room was currently unlocked and that it was not able to be locked by them from the inside of the room. [REDACTED] 04 stated that as the gunshots seemed to him to be getting farther away, he opened

the door of the meeting room and could smell what was known to him to be gunpowder. 04 said that he and a few of his other colleagues began to run. 04 said that he exited the meeting room into the hallway, turned right (facing south/southwest), and ran down the hallway (south/southwest), away from the sound of the gunshots. 04 continued to run down the hallway to an exit door on the right side (west side) toward the rear of the school and exited through that door. Once outside, 04 ran in a northwesterly direction, up and over a small embankment. 04 continued to run in a northwesterly direction until reaching the Villa Restaurant And Pizza, 4 Riverside Road, Sandy Hook, CT (an approximate distance of 215 yards). 04 stated that he entered the restaurant and used a phone to call 9-1-1 and reported the incident to police.

04 said he believed that possibly two of the female teachers who were initially with him in the meeting room, had remained inside that room after he had left. 04 said that after the incident he had met up with one of the female teachers who had remained in the room who told 04 that she and another female teacher had broken out a glass window in the room, crawled out through the window, and ran from the school to escape.
