Witness Statement of 04

Date and Time of Investigation:

December 14th, 2012 at approximately 1235 hours

Summary of Incident:

On the above mentioned date and time members of the Statewide Narcotics Task Force Northwest Office responded to the scene of Sandy Hook Elementary School located at 12 Dickinson Drive in Newtown Connecticut on a report of an active shooter within the school. This writer interviewed several witnesses that were inside the school when the shooting occurred, witnesses were asked to give written statements about the incident that occurred.

ACTION TAKEN:

THE UNDERSIGNED, AN INVESTIGATOR HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND SAYS THAT: I AM THE WRITER OF THE ATTACHED POLICE REPORT PERTAINING TO THIS INCIDENT NUMBER. 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On December 14, 2012 at approximately 1235 hours, this writer interviewed [REDACTED] 04, 03 [REDACTED], at the Sandy Hook Fire Department regarding her observations involving a shooting incident which had taken place at approximately 0930 hours at Sandy Hook Elementary School, 12 Dickinson Drive, Newtown, CT. 04 a teacher was present inside the school when the incident began. 04 provided her own one-page handwritten witness statement. 04 provided the following information:

04 stated that on December 14, 2012 at approximately 9:25 -9:30 she had a class in the Library and they kept hearing clicking on the loudspeaker. 04 called the office and they told her there was shooting in the office. 04 stated that 04 told her "LOCKDOWN NOW", they got kids in between the bookshelves, 04 then went to cover the door windows and then she went to her desk to get her keys. 04 locked (two) 2 of the doors, she went to lock the 3rd door and she saw a guy in the hallway with a gun. 04 stated that she shut the door but couldn't lock the door from the inside, so she barricaded the door with some printers. 04 stated that she moved the kids crawling on the floor into the back kitchen in the library and into the closet behind the kitchen because she knew she was able to lock those doors. 04 stated that she had 18 kids and 4 Library personnel, they moved the file cabinets to block the door. 04 stated they could hear lots of banging but couldn't tell what it was. 04 stated that they had cell phones and sent texted messages to 04 to have him call police to let them know where they were. 04 stated that SWAT team came to escort them out. (see attached original statement)

On January 16, 2013 at approximately 1600 hrs this writer contacted [REDACTED] 04 via telephone number [REDACTED] 04, 03 to ask her about her observations on the morning of December 14, 2012. This writer asked 04 about the man that she saw in the hallway with a gun. 04 verbally told this writer that she did not have her glasses on when she observed the man with the gun, but she believed that he was a first responder. 04 stated the man was not dressed in a uniform, and was not clearly identified as a Police Officer.
