Action Taken: On 1/6/13, this Detective received an e-mail message from **01 02 03 12** regarding, in part, additional information relayed to her by her son, **01 02 03 12** who was a student in **01 02** classroom (see attached.)

01 02 03 12 stated that her son, **01 02 03 12** told her a longer and more detailed version of what he had told her earlier. **01 02 03 12** stated that **01 02 03 12** told her that **01 02** told the children to line up against the wall in the classroom because they heard a small amount of gunshots and that the teacher (unspecified in the e-mail if it was **01 02 03 12** was looking either out the door into the hall or out the window into the hall when the shooter "busted in" and was firing the gun in the room. **01 02 03 12** told his mother that he saw **01 02** fall down, and stated that he saw the bullets or casings coming out of the gun. **01 02 03 12** stated that he was ducking behind a desk in the classroom and that the gunman had come in through the hallway door to the classroom. **01 02 03 12** stated that he and the other children ran while he was reloading, and that the children running in front of him were **01 02 03 12** additionally stated that **01 02 03 12** was in the group of children running as well, but that he did not know where. **01 02 03 12** advised that there was smoke in the hallway, and that he saw blood and bodies in the hallway as well.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.

He said [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 told them to line up against the wall because they heard a small amount if shots. He said the teacher was looking out the hallway door (maybe window) and he busted in and was firing the gun in the room. He saw [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 fall down. He said he saw the bullets or casings coming out of the gun. He said he was ducking behind a desk. Is was the hallway door. He said when he was reloading they ran. He told me the order of the kids who were in front of him [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12. He did not know where [REDACTED] 01 02 03 12 was in the order but he ran too. He said there was smoke in the hallway. He saw blood and bodies in the hallway.
Please just keep our group in the loop. We are all very anxious to meet.



> don't disclose anything during an open investigation, but this
> situation is so different in so many ways that we want to try to give
> everyone what they need as best we can. I just sent out an email to
> all the parents you had given my contact info to in an attempt to
> identify who might know the owners of some of the property I still
> have at my desk...I will email you as soon as my boss tells me where
