ACTION TAKEN:

On the morning of Friday, December 14th, 2012, I responded to an active shooter incident at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Sandy Hook CT. Shortly after arriving, I was assigned to speak with and obtain a statement from 04, 03 is employed as a 04 and was working at Sandy Hook Elementary School when the shooting incident occurred. I located and spoke with 04 at the Sandy Hook Volunteer Fire and Rescue Station, located at 18-20 Riverside Rd., Sandy Hook, CT. The Fire and Rescue Station was designated and being utilized as a staging area for first responders as well as a gathering and meeting point for school staff, students and their respective families.

I provided 04 with a piece of formal statement paper and asked if she could write, in narrative format, her recollection of the events that she was part of or witness to during the shooting incident at the Sandy Hook Elementary School. In said statement, she related that she left 04

room (room 04) and was walking northerly in the east hallway, toward the front of the school. She was walking with her student (01 02 03 12) and as they were just about to turn onto the north hallway and proceed to the school resource room (room #6), she heard the sound of gunfire. As she then turned the corner onto the north hallway, she observed Principal Hochspring exiting the conference room in a panic, looking around. At this time 04 paused, unsure if she should proceed toward her room or retreat back to the east hallway. As she stood there, she saw the Principal proceed toward the main lobby following which 04 heard additional gunfire.

Although in her original written account of events, 04 thought she had seen a man in the lobby area, she later related verbally that she didn't think she actually saw anyone. She clarified that after the Principal proceeded toward the main lobby, 04 grabbed her student and then turned and ran back toward 04 room, fleeing southerly down the east hallway. While running in the east hallway, she saw a man standing in the hallway who asked her, "What?" 04 replied, stating that she did not know. During this whole time, she continued hearing the sound of gunfire. 04 proceeded into the art room (room #51) and advised the teacher in the class that she thought there was a shooter in the school. She then sought refuge in the art room with her student until the police arrived and evacuated them.

04 related that the male she saw in the east hallway was wearing dark clothes and a waist length coat. He was a white male and had his hands in his pocket. Sometime after the incident, 04 was informed that the male she saw in the east hallway was a student's parent in the school who was waiting to meet with a kindergarten teacher. She related that he was near the entrance which is used by pre-school parents to enter the school to drop off their children. (See Attached Statement)

CASE STATUS: This case remains active pending further investigation.
