INTERVIEW OF **01 02 03 12**

On 12/14/12 at approximately 1130 members of the Fairfield Police Department Detective Bureau responded to the Newtown Police department to assist them after a report of a school shooting at the Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newtown.

We were asked by the Newtown Police to speak with some of the students who may have witnessed the shooter inside Sandy Hook School. We were told that the students were all in the care of their respective parents at the police department. Newtown Police requested that the students/witnesses be interviewed promptly to confirm or deny rumors that there was a second shooter who fled the scene. Connecticut State Police Sgt. Mike DeCesare along with Fairfield Detective Lieutenant Mike Gagner, Sgt. Tony Granata and Detectives Alex Fucci, Belinda Papageorge and myself began to the interviews of the children who all were willing to speak with us in the presence of their respective parents.

Detective papageorge and I first interviewed **01 02 03 12**.

01 02 03 12 is a first grade student at Sandy Hook and was in **01 02 03 12** class of 16 students on the morning of 12/14/12.

01 02 03 12 stated that the schoolday began as any normal day and they were going over Math when they heard what they thought was a loud hammer banging something. Then, a man dressed in green and beige "Army" clothes came into her classroom, didn't say anything and "began shooting random people like **01 02 03 12** with his rifle. **01 02 03 12** said that the gunman shot **01 02** and her teacher's assistant who passed out from the shock and then the gunman shot her anyway. **01 02 03 12** stated that she didn't want to die, she wanted to live so she ran the fastest she could with four male classmates and they were found by **04** her Mom's friend on the way to the Firehouse.


