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ACTION TAKEN: On 02/13/13 at approximately 1118 hours, Detective Mudry #824 and I met with [redacted] 04 at SHES, with regards to the ongoing investigation. The purpose of this interview was to clarify her initial statement that was given during a previous interview. During the interview, [redacted] 04 stated, in part the following:

That on 12/14/12, she was with student [redacted] 01 02 03 12. [redacted] 04 stated that she cannot remember the exact or approximate time of anything that she did. [redacted] 04 stated that on 12-14-12, she was walking by way of the back hallway of the school having come from [redacted] 04 and going to [redacted] 04. [redacted] 04 stated that [redacted] 01 02 03 12 was walking in front of her and as [redacted] 01 02 03 12 rounded the corner of the first grade hallway, [redacted] 04 heard the first sound (like metal crashing). [redacted] 04 stated that she initially thought about the custodian and that something may have happened on the roof. When she stepped into the main hallway, [redacted] 04 stated that she watched Dawn Hochsprung come out of the conference room and they looked at each other, wondering what the noise was. [redacted] 04 stated that she put up her arms as if to say "what was that?" and to let her know that it was not happening where she was. [redacted] 04 stated that Hochsprung then walked toward the main entrance. [redacted] 04 stated that she heard the loud noise again and saw Hochsprung's body language indicate shock. [redacted] 04 stated that Hochsprung was standing just before the bench in the lobby. [redacted] 04 stated that she grabbed her student and ran away from the lobby passing a man standing outside one of the classrooms. He looked at her and said "what" and she told him that she thought there was a shooter in the building. [redacted] 04 stated that she ran with her student to the art room and heard multiple consecutive gunshots that were like pop, pop, pop, then a pause and then multiple shots. [redacted] 04 stated that she got to [redacted] 04 room and they locked themselves in an inner room. [redacted] 04 stated that she could not hear anything else. [redacted] 04 stated that she did not see Mary Sherlach with Hochsprung or see them fall to the floor.
