ACTION TAKEN:

On 03/05/13, at approximately 1235 hours, Detective Downs #502 and I met with **04, 03**, at Chalk Hill Elementary School with regards to the ongoing investigation. **04** was initially interviewed on 12-14-12 at Bridgeport Hospital, and she informed us that she

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had no recollection of the interview taking place or what she had stated. After this interview, 04 was given her initial statement to read. During the interview, 04 stated, in part, the following:

That on 12/14/12, she was working 04 as an 04 at SHES. She was 04 At 8 a.m. she unlocked her front door and kept it unlocked. The rear vestibule door was also unlocked. This door leads to the exit doors to the outside playground and the door to the other classroom adjacent to hers. At about 930, the children were on the carpet with the other teachers, and she was near the cubby holes by the front door going through the children's backpacks and school papers. At that time, she heard a noise that sounded like corrugated tin falling. 04 stated that she went into the hallway thinking that the custodian had dropped something. 04 stated that she stepped out of the room a few steps with the first noise. There was a pause in the noise and then she heard it again. 04 described it as sounding the same as the first time she heard it. 04 stated that she saw 04 another teacher, walking with her student down the hallway to her left. 04 stated that she took a few steps further (described as going toward the lobby) and saw Dawn Hochsprung and Mary Sherlach come running out of the conference room, together. 04 stated that they both took a left out of the conference room and continued down the hallway to the office, where they took a left down the other hallway (described as toward the cafeteria). 04 stated that she does not remember seeing anything else down the hallway toward the lobby and she does not remember if she saw Natalie Hammond. 04 stated that she got to 04 she got the feeling that something was not right and she turned to go back to her classroom. 04 stated that as she was turning, she felt that something was not right with her foot, and she did not know that she was shot. 04 stated that while walking back to her classroom, she did not see 04 anymore. 04 stated that when she got back to her classroom, she made sure that all her doors were closed properly. 04 stated that as she was doing so, she could feel that her left foot was squishy and when she got behind the bookcase, she saw the blood. 04 stated that she stayed behind the bookcase while 04 had the children on the carpet in lockdown mode. 04 stated that they could hear the PA system and could hear people talking about being shot. 04 stated that the gunshots could be described as "pop, pop, pop". The gunshots sounded like they originated from the front and were getting louder, moving closer to her. The shots also sounded like a series of a couple of shots and then a break. 04 stated that she heard that break in shots a couple of times. 04 stated that when the police came, her class was escorted out the rear vestibule door in her classroom.
