On 05/03/13 at approximately 1420 hours, Detective Mudry # 824 and I met with **01 02 03 12, 04** with regards to this investigation. **01 02 03 12, 04** is the father of **01 02 03 12**, a student at Sandy Hook Elementary School. **01 02 03 12** was the student in the bathroom in

01 02 03 12 with her teachers, 04, on December 14, 2012. 01 02 03 12, 04 had informed Detective Downs and I, during a family meeting, that since the day of 12/14/12 and thereafter, his daughter has been talking to him and his wife about the things that she saw and heard while in the bathroom during the shooting. 01 02 03 12, 04 had agreed to put the information into a statement for us. During the interview, 01 02 03 12, 04 stated, in part, the following:

That on December 14, 2012 01 02 03 12 heard "hammering" and "bangs" while she was picking out a book to read in 04 reading room. That 01 02 03 12 and her two teachers went into the single person bathroom where they stood quietly while the "hammering" was going on. That while in the bathroom, 01 02 03 12 heard a child screaming, "help me" and "I don't want to be here!" 01 02 03 12 also stated that she heard an "angry" man shouting in response to the last statement, "well you're here!"

01 02 03 12, 04 stated that 01 02 03 12 also told him that she saw the light go on in the reading room outside of the bathroom and that she heard more "bangs" after that. 01 02 03 12, 04 stated that while in the bathroom, 01 02 03 12 also heard a man scream "he's got a hammer!" 01 02 03 12, 04 stated that his best assumption was that 01 02 03 12 heard a law enforcement officer yell "he's got a handgun."

01 02 03 12, 04 stated that his daughter told him about the shooter talking in the later part of February, when he sat her down and asked her questions about what she experienced on 12/14/12. 01 02 03 12, 04 also stated that 01 02 03 12 told them that when she exited the school, she saw big drops of blood on the hallway floor, broken glass, a "policeman holding a boy who had his eyes closed", and a lady with bandages on her arms in an ambulance. 01 02 03 12, 04 stated that 01 02 03 12 also told him that she was the first one at the firehouse and that she saw her friend's sister covered in blood, but that she was not hurt.
