ACTION TAKEN: On 07/26/13, at approximately 0907 hours, Detective Downs and I met with [REDACTED] 04, at her residence with regards to the ongoing investigation. The purpose of the interview was to clarify statements that she had previously given to Trooper

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McDonald on 12-14-12. During the interview, 04 stated, in part, the following:

On 12-14-12, she 01 02 03 12. It was too early for her to be at work (10:00 AM) so she ran errands and then made her way to the school. While on Church Hill Rd, she saw Newtown PD DARE vehicles (not cruisers) going lights and sirens toward the school and had to pull over to let them pass. 04 stated that she saw the cars take a right onto Washington (going toward the rear of the school) and thought that the cars were not going to the school. 04 stated that when she got to the corner of Dickinson and Riverside Drive, she saw a group of children running on Riverside. They were passed the large doors of the firehouse (which would be the northern edge of the property, furthest from the school) and a bunch of cars were pulled over. 04 stated that her first thought was why are these kids running and leaving the daycare. 04 stated that when she pulled onto Dickinson Drive, she does not remember seeing any police cars until she got to the stop sign (at the beginning of the driveway). She saw many in the parking lot and she saw a uniformed policeman running toward the school on the right side of her car with a gun. 04 stated that the police kept coming and she was thinking we don't have this many police in Newtown. 04 stated that while stopped at the stop sign, she called her husband to tell him that something is going on. 04 stated that she thought it was 9:34 but he thought it was 9:40. 04 stated that she then pulled into the first parking lot and parked in the last space where she remained in her 04. While in the parking lot, 04 stated that she saw a police officer carry a young child to an ambulance that had showed up way after her arrival. 04 stated that she also saw a man restrained by cops and then later unrestrained in the parking lot and she did not know at the time but later learned that it was 04, a parent. 04 stated that at no time did she approach the school and she and her husband were eventually 01 02 03 12, 04

See attached written statement prepared and notarized by me, witnessed by Detective Downs, and sworn to and signed by 04

During the interview, 04 attempted to locate her telephone records for 12/14/12 to determine what time it was that she called her husband, and was unable to find the records, but knew she saved them somewhere. 04 later called me and left a message that she found the records and her telephone records indicated that it was 9:40 AM when she arrived at the school and called her husband.

Upon further review of Newtown Police Officer SGT Bahamonde's dash cam video, I was able to find 04 parked at the stop sign at the end of Dickinson Drive prior to the driveway to the school in her Nissan Pathfinder. The video also shows the cars pulled over on Riverside Drive. The time stamp on the video was 09:40:04.
