INTERVIEW REPORT - 01 02 03 12

On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1200hrs I was directed to the Newtown Police Department where several of the surviving Sandy Hook Elementary School students had been brought following the shooting which occurred at the school. The parents of many of the students were also at Newtown PD with their children offering them support. Upon my arrival I met with numerous officers from various law enforcement agencies, and after gathering the details of the incident several of us began privately interviewing the surviving children with their parents inside the police department.

I met with student [redacted] 01 02 03 12 and his father [redacted] 01 02 03 12 and brought them into an unoccupied private office within the Newtown Police Department. [redacted] 01 02 03 12 is a 01 02 03 12 student at Sandy Hook Elementary School and is in 01 02 03 12. He seemed calm and quiet, but responded politely and articulately when asked questions. [redacted] 01 02 03 12 stated that he was willing to talk about what happened at the school that morning, and his father agreed to let him be interviewed. I explained to [redacted] 01 02 03 12 that if at any time it appeared that [redacted] 01 02 03 12 was having difficulty speaking about the incident, the interview would end and could be rescheduled for another time. Both [redacted] 01 02 03 12 and his father indicated that they were willing to help out the investigation by giving as much detail as possible about the incident while it was still fresh in [redacted] 01 02 03 12 mind.

Rather than take notes and transcribe [redacted] 01 02 03 12 statement at the conclusion of the interview, I chose to write the statement as we went along to facilitate [redacted] 01 02 03 12 being able to go back home as quickly as possible to be with his family. At the conclusion of the interview, [redacted] 01 02 03 12 signed the

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statement as a witness under his son's signature on the bottom of the statement. The following is a summary of 01 02 03 12 statement.

01 02 03 12 stated that he is a 01 02 03 12 student at Sandy Hook Elementary School in 01 02 03 12 class which has a total of sixteen children in it. On 12/14/2012 he took the bus to school at 0830hrs, and when he got to school he went into his classroom, hung up his coat and placed his backpack into his cubby hole. 01 02 03 12 then signed up for lunch and worked on a drawing of a gingerbread man. He completed his morning work and the class then had their morning meeting in the circle area of the classroom. After the morning meeting, they read the morning message on the Smart Board in the classroom. 01 02 03 12 said he then heard some loud noises coming from outside the classroom that he thought came from a hammer, and 01 02 03 12 told them to get to the back of the classroom. They all started to do that when the classroom door "banged open" and a man with a gun came into the classroom. 01 02 03 12 described the man as tall and skinny with light skin and a light brown beard that was short. He stated that he was wearing a green army style hat with straps, a green shirt and camouflage pants. 01 02 03 12 described the man's gun as a "long bazooka style gun." He stated that the man shot 01 02 03 12 first, who was standing by the classroom windows, and she fell down. 01 02 03 12 stated that he and some of his classmates began running toward the classroom door to get outside, and that everyone was screaming. His classmate 01 02 03 12 tripped by the door as they ran out. He did not see the man shoot any of the kids in the classroom, and the man never said a word. 01 02 03 12 saw two adults lying in the hallway outside the classroom as they all ran toward the front door of the school. He stated that this is the route they take for fire drills, and that is why they went that way. When they got outside they began to go toward the playground, but saw 01 02 03 12 friend's mother and they told her what had happened. 01 02 03 12 stated that she told them all to get into her van and she brought them down to the police station.
