### INTERVIEW OF 01 02 03 12

On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1130 hours members of the Fairfield Police Detective Bureau responded to Newtown Police Department to assist them after a school shooting took place at Sandy Hook Elementary School, Newtown.

We were detailed to interview students who witnessed the shooting inside Sandy Hook School. The objective was to obtain a thumbnail sketch of what happened, and to confirm/deny reports of a second shooter.

I first spoke with [Redacted] 04 who stated [Redacted] 01 02 03 12 saw "everything". They gave me permission to interview him regarding what happened, and the four of us sat privately in a Newtown PD office.

[Redacted] 01 02 03 12 stated he is a [Redacted] 01 02 03 12 class, which according to [Redacted] 01 02 03 12 is just several doors down from the principal's office. He said they had just finished writing class when he heard loud shooting coming from the hall. After a few moments, the classroom door opened and a "bad man" entered the room and started shooting everyone in the class.

[Redacted] 01 02 03 12 said the shooter was dressed in "army clothes" and was firing a "bazooka". He thought the shooter had dark skin and a beard.

[Redacted] 01 02 03 12 said he saw his teacher [Redacted] 01 02 03 12 get shot and said she was "dead". He also said he saw at least two of his classmates get shot and referred to them as "dead" as well. He said the shooter shot at him multiple times but missed, and instead struck [Redacted] 01 02 03 12, which he had been holding in his hand. [Redacted] 01 02 03 12 said he dropped his stuffed animal and ran.

[Redacted] 01 02 03 12 stated he ran out of his classroom, into the hall, and right past his principal (Dawn Hochsprung), who was on the floor in the hallway "dead". He said he exited the school and "ran, and ran, and ran" until a woman driving by saw him, stopped, picked him up, and drove him to the police station. It should be noted that [Redacted] 01 02 03 12 filed the school with several other children, who were also picked up by the same person and driven to the police station where they were ultimately reunited with their parents. The identity of this woman is unknown, however, open source/media reports indicate the woman was a parent who happened to be running an errand at the school and came upon the kids running across the parking lot screaming about a man "shooting everyone".

[Redacted] 01 02 03 12 stated the shooter did not speak or yell, he just fired at everyone in the class. We spoke about the "bazooka" the man was carrying, and based his additional description (long, and the shooter used both hands), I concluded the shooter was likely armed with a rifle.

## CASE/INCIDENT REPORT

01 02 03 12 answered questions willingly, but was obviously traumatized. I asked no follow-up questions regarding his teacher or his classmates, or the injuries they sustained, as it would have been outside the scope of the interview and would have unduly traumatized the child further.

The children interviewed all gave consistent accounts of the incident and we were able to conclude that one shooter entered 01 02 03 12


