INTERVIEW OF 01 02 03 12


On 12/14/2012 at approximately 1130 hours members of the Fairfield Police Detective Bureau responded to Newtown Police Department to assist them after the report of a school shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School in their town.

We were asked by Newtown Police to speak with some of the students who witnessed the shooter inside Sandy Hook School. We were told the students were currently with their parents at the department. Newtown Police requested the students/witnesses be interviewed promptly to confirm or deny rumors of a second shooter. State Police Sgt. Mike DeCesare along with Fairfield Detective Lieutenant Mike Gagner and Detectives Alex Fucci, Bernard Kelley, Belinda Papageorge and I began the interviews.

DET Alex Fucci and I spoke with [redacted] 01 02 03 12, along with [redacted] 04, 01 02 03 12

01 02 03 12 is a 01 02 03 12 class of 16 students. 01 02 03 12 account of the incident is as follows:

01 02 03 12 said he was in the classroom and his classroom door was open when he began hearing loud noise come from outside his classroom. He recalled the intercom being on in the school and then he saw a white man with all green clothing and a green hat, with black boots, walk into his classroom carrying a gun. 01 02 03 12 described the gun as, "the man needed two hands to hold it." The man shot his gun all around in every direction. 01 02 03 12 said he thinks he heard about 10 shots but described them as very fast. The room then filled of smoke. He described the man as "being the age of a dad" when asked how old the shooter looked. He said the shooter said nothing, he just shot at glass and the kids around him. 01 02 03 12 then ran outside the class where he saw his principal with blood on her outside the office (specific office unknown). 01 02 03 12 said he heard more gun shots after he ran out of the classroom. He ran outside the school into the road with 5 other classmates named [redacted] 01 02 03 12


