Interview: On 12/14/12, at approximately 1230 hours, this Detective met with [Redacted] 04, 03, at the Sandy Hook firehouse and obtained a statement regarding the ongoing investigation. 04 stated, in part, the following:

That she and her class of 16 students were at morning meeting in their classroom, Room 04 at Sandy Hook Elementary School, at approximately 9:25 a.m., when they heard "popping sounds." 04 stated that her 04 checked out in the hallway and then came back into the classroom and said to lock the door. 04 stated that they followed the lock-down procedures dictated by the school and had the students all move to where the backpacks were while 04 locked the classroom door. 04 stated that they heard yelling and more popping sounds in the hallway, so she and her students stayed low to the ground and were "quiet and brave" while 04 called 911 to report the shooting to the police. 04 stated that 04 stayed on the line with the police and that at some point someone jiggled the door trying to open it. 04 stated that approximately 15 minutes later around 10 a.m., a police officer banged on the door and directed them to let him in, which they didn't. 04 stated that she heard him yelling to the other teachers to get the kids out of the building and then heard other teachers voices so she peeked out the door and saw a police officer in the hall who told her and her students to evacuate the building. 04 stated that she had her students hold hands and together they all ran to the fire house.

04 relayed that she arrived at S.H.E.S. at approximately 8 a.m. that morning, and was asked if she had observed any suspicious persons in or around the building at that time or in the past days or weeks, but stated that she had not. 04 was asked if she knew of any angry parents or families lashing out at teachers or the school lately, and stated that she did not, but that she did have one 01 02 03 12

04 was asked what the pattern of gunshots was and she relayed that it was a continuous popping sound. 04 was asked about the intercom system going off during the incident and stated that it was on for a time, but that there was no message being relayed, it was just open static and background noises.

The status of the case remains actively under investigation.
