Interview: On 12/14/12, this Detective and Detective Allegro #950, responded to 04, 03; and met with 04 teacher 04, 03 of the aforementioned address, with regards to the ongoing investigation.

During the interview, 04 stated, in part, the following:

That she usually arrives at Sandy Hook Elementary School at 8 a.m. 04 stated that over the past few weeks, she has not noticed anything or anyone suspicious in or around the school. 04 stated that she always enters the school through the front doors in the morning upon arrival, and clarified that prior to the arrival of the students, the janitor leaves the front door open for the staff and faculty to enter, and that the doors are locked once the students arrive, with all persons without a key having to be buzzed into the building by staff in the main office.

When asked about any recent incidents that she could recall in which there were angry parents or persons involved, she recalled one incident recently pertaining to a school bus issue where a parent wasn't at a bus stop to collect their child as necessary, but 04 stated that it had nothing to do with her or her students, and further clarified that she only heard about the incident through another 1st grade teacher, Vicki Soto.

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04 stated that she had not been at the Sandy Hook Elementary School today, 12/14/12, due to the fact that she had a scheduled day off so that she could attend a medical appointment. 04 stated that 04 as arranged by the school secretary. 04 stated that there are two building substitutes, which are the first two used to fill absences or cover classes, and that if those two building subs are already being used or are not available, then the school uses a substitute teacher from the pool of available subs for the district. 04 stated that her classroom 04 04 stated that her classroom door does lock from the outside if you have the key, and that as such, you need to step into the hallway to secure the door from the outside. 04 stated that the substitute teacher would have had the key to lock the door in that manner.

04 stated that she had been watching the news and was aware of the name of the suspect, but did not know him, and furthermore, did not recognize the name of his mother, whom was reportedly being identified as a kindergarten teacher in the school. 04 stated that there is no such teacher or staff member at the school with the same last name.

04 asked about her students and was advised that the only child that this Detective had confirmation about at that time was 01 02 03 12. 04 stated that she had been advised by another teacher that they had seen 01 02 03 12 after the incident, and that 01 02 03 12 had relayed to the teacher that she had played or pretended to be dead during the incident. 04 knew no other details.

See attached written statement prepared and notarized by this Detective, sworn to and signed by 04 and witnessed by Detective Allegro.

It should be noted that during the interview there were two signed sworn statements taken from 04 in succession. Detective Allegro took a statement from 04 pertaining specifically to a possible disturbance at the school the day prior to the shooting and her pre-scheduled absence from school on 12/14/12, and this Detective took a more generalized informational statement from 04.

The status of the case remains active under investigation.
