Action Taken: On 12/27/12, this Detective responded to the 01 02 03 12, 04 residence, located at 01 02 03 12 and met briefly with 01 02 03 12, 04. This Detective relayed her contact information and advised that I would be the liaison for the forensic interview of 01 02 03 12 scheduled for 12/28/12 at 11 a.m. This Detective also provided 01 02 03 12, with a copy of a children's picture book for his son, focusing on traumatic events entitled "A Terrible Thing Happened."

On 12/27/12, this Detective received a telephone call from 01 02 03 12, 04, who advised that she was struggling with the decision as to whether or not to have her son partake in the forensic interview, as she didn't want to miss an opportunity that might be good for 01 02 03 12 but stated that he was adamant that he was not coming to the interview and did not want to speak with anyone.

01 02 03 12, 04 was advised that an interview had been conducted earlier that morning and had gone well, but that the child in that instance had been willing and ready to disclose the information. This Detective relayed that if 01 02 03 12 did not want to come to the interview, then it was not appropriate to bring him in. 01 02 03 12, 04 relayed that their family was meeting with a trauma team/specialist for counseling in the next week to begin helping 01 02 03 12 work through his issues, and was told that this Detective and the rest of the services offered came with an open door policy with no time constraints associated for whatever they needed for their son or family.

01 02 03 12, 04 asked if the police needed to know what 01 02 03 12 had told them, and this Detective stated that if she and/or her husband were able and ready to share that information that we, the State Police, would like to take a statement from them, but that it was understood that this incident was emotionally charged for the whole family and that they needed to do what was right for them first. 01 02 03 12, 04 thanked this Detective for .
