On 12-14-12 at or about 0930 hours this Trooper was working an HCP assignment in Oxford when the report of an "active shooter" incident was taking place in Newtown. It was later determined that the incident was taking place at Sandy Hook Elementary School (SHES) in Newtown. This Trooper left the HCP assignment with TFC Macisco, #906, and responded lights and siren to the scene of the active shooter incident. This Trooper arrived at or about 1000 hours. As this Trooper arrived, students were already being escorted down Dickenson Drive to the fire house. This Trooper parked on Dickenson Drive and proceeded the remaining distance up the hill to the front parking lot of SHES on foot. Law enforcement personnel were inside the building and had taken security posts around the building. At this point during the incident, it was being reported that there was the possibility of more than one shooter involved.

This Trooper partnered with DEEP Officer Keith Williams and searched the wood line behind SHES. There was nothing in the wood line that was determined to be beneficial to the investigation. After exiting the wood line this Trooper and Officer Williams were on Crestwood Drive, which runs adjacent to the wood line and the rear of the SHES building. This Trooper encountered [REDACTED] 04, 03, as he stood [REDACTED] 04. [REDACTED] 04 said he lived at [REDACTED] 04 and had been in the driveway of his home the entire time and stated he did not see anyone in the wood line, except for clearly identified law enforcement personnel. [REDACTED] 04 stated that the house at the end of Crestwood Road was #14 and was a [REDACTED] 04 on vacation. This Trooper and Officer Williams went to #14 Crestwood Road and found the property to be secured with no signs of anyone tampering with the property. This Trooper and Officer Williams searched the wooded area around # 14 Crestwood and did not find anything beneficial to the investigation.

While searching the wooded area around #14 Crestwood a hiking trail was found that led away from Crestwood Road and SHES. This Trooper and Officer Williams followed the trail out to an area of wetlands and turned around. There was nothing found on the trail that would be beneficial to the investigation. The trail led back to SHES.

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While still in the wood line, a vehicle, CT registration 04, 01 02, was seen driving down Crestwood Road. This Trooper and Officer Williams stopped the vehicle. It was operated by 04, 03, 01 02. 04, 01 02 stated that he had two children in the building and was looking for a way to locate them. He stated that he was unable to get to the firehouse and was trying to find a different way around.

A second vehicle, CT registration 04, was stopped on Crestwood. The vehicle was operated by 04, 01 02, 03. The front seat passenger was 04, 01 02, 03. They stated that they had a child at SHES and could not get to the firehouse and were looking for a different way around.

This Trooper and Officer Williams assumed a security post between # 5 and #8 Crestwood Drive, at the area of the rear gate to the playground at SHES. The gate had a lock and chain that was cut, with the chain re-attached to the gate. The cut link was found the ground near the gate. Also on the ground was a black pouch that resembled a glove pouch issued to law enforcement personnel. At 1423 hours this Trooper and Officer Williams were relieved of our security post by Newtown P.D. Officers Smith, #92, and Seabrook, #95. They were made aware of the cut chain and the pouch on the ground. It was explained to them that the cut chain looked suspicious and no one could account for the black pouch on the ground.

This Trooper located SGT Thomas, #129, CDMC supervisor, and was directed to respond to the EOC established at the Fairfield Hills property in Newtown. At or about 1445 hours, this Trooper left the scene at SHES and responded to the EOC.

This case remains open.
