
On the morning of December 14, 2012 I was telephonically contacted at my desk, located within the FBI New Haven Field Office, by Lieutenant William Baldwin, Commanding Officer of Central District Major Crime. Lieutenant Baldwin informed me that there was an "active shooter" at the Sandy Hook Elementary School located in Newtown, Connecticut. Lieutenant Baldwin informed me that preliminary information received indicated several people, to include children, had been shot.

I immediately notified FBI Supervisory Special Agent Kevin Kline of the reported active shooting. SA Kline informed me that he had just been notified of the shooting a minute or two before I entered his office. Furthermore, SA Kline informed me that the FBI SWAT Team was en-route to Sandy Hook to provide tactical assistance.

I proceeded to make an emergency response to the Sandy Hook Elementary School with FBI Special Agent Bomb Technician Samuel DiPasquale following.

Upon arrival at the scene, I parked my assigned CSP vehicle at the intersection of Riverside Road and Dickinson Drive. I was immediately approached by family members and parents who were in search of children (students) or relatives of the Sandy Hook School. I directed these individuals to the Sandy Hook Fire House, which already appeared to be utilized as a command post/staging area.

I proceeded down to the Sandy Hook Elementary School and received a quick briefing from a CSP Trooper and Newtown Police Officer on scene. Both informed me that numerous children and adults had been shot and killed and were within the classrooms. Peering in the classroom windows, I could see numerous victims laying about the classroom floors. The Newtown Police Officer informed me that one of the shooters was deceased within the school and they were uncertain if there were additional accomplices or perpetrators. I was also informed that all the surviving

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
occupants had been evacuated from the school.

I responded back up to the firehouse and met up with Major Hyatt. Major Hyatt informed me he was trying to coordinate returning students to their respective parents at the firehouse. He further informed me that some students had been evacuated to a nearby daycare and it was rumored that a few students had fled on foot to neighboring houses when the shooting started. Major Hyatt tasked me to conduct a neighborhood canvass of the houses northwest of the school's location to determine if students had fled to the near-by residences.

I subsequently formed two teams of CSP Troopers to conduct a quick neighborhood canvass in search of survivors (Team members: TFC Steve Sordi #560, TFC Laurie DelTorto #517 and TFC Bill Arbor #315). Teams canvassed residences located northwest of the school's location. One team canvassed/searched residences on the north side of Riverside Road while the other canvassed/searched the south. Personnel were instructed to enter any unlocked, unoccupied, residences and out buildings in search of students who may have fled the school seeking a safe-haven. Personnel were instructed to interview members of occupied residences with regards to observations of fleeing children and potential accomplices to the shooting. Personnel were instructed to be mindful of officer safety while conducting their searches because potential accomplices to the shooting had not yet been ruled out. The following Riverside Road residences were canvassed/searched: number(s): 17, 17A, 19, 19B, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 31, 34. Unlocked/unoccupied residences and outbuildings were entered by CSP personnel. No survivors were located at the aforementioned addresses.

I subsequently returned to the firehouse with both CSP teams and informed Major Hyatt of our findings. I was then tasked by Major Hyatt to assist Major Crime in coordinating "witness interviews" of individuals within the firehouse. I met up with Sgt. Davison, CSP Major Crime, and briefly assisted with the aforementioned task. Sensing that my services were no longer required, I dismissed myself and asked Major Hyatt if my services could be utilized elsewhere.

Major Hyatt subsequently assigned me to assist with coordinating the assignment of Liaison Officers/Troopers to families who were unable to locate their missing child or family member. (End Report-See Supplementary Family Liaison Report)

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
