**INTERVIEW/ STATEMENT REPORT**

INTERVIEWED: Newtown Police Officer Jason Flynn  
3 Main St, Newtown CT 06470

DATE AND TIME: Tuesday, December 18th, 2012 1215 - 1348 Hrs

LOCATION: Detective Bureau Newtown Police Department

PURPOSE: Interview Newtown Police Department First Responders, responding to the Sandy Hook Elementary School murders

BACKGROUND: On Friday, December 14th, 2012, Newtown Police Officer Jason Flynn was acting in his official capacity as School Resource Officer at Newtown High School. At about 9:30 AM, he heard an inaudible radio dispatch. After several attempts he reached dispatch and was informed of a shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School with the possibility of a second shooter at large. Officer Flynn remained at the school. Officer Flynn and Assistant Principal Jason Hiruo proceeded to lock down the high school.

THE UNDERSIGNED, AN INVESTIGATOR HAVING BEEN DULY SWORN DEPOSES AND SAYS THAT: I AM THE WRITER OF THE ATTACHED POLICE REPORT PERTAINING TO THIS INCIDENT NUMBER. 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ACTION TAKEN: On Tuesday, December 18th, at approximately 1200 Hrs, Detective Combes and I met with Officer Jason Flynn at the Detective Bureau, Newtown Police Department to conduct his interview. After conducting the interview, Officer Flynn wrote and signed his sworn statement.

Officer Flynn wrote the following: "On 12/14/2012 I was acting in my official capacity as the School Resource Officer at Newtown High School. At approximately 9:30 a.m. I was in the Assistant Principals Office with Assistant Principal Kathy Boettner. I was with Boettner interviewing students regarding a sexual assault case. During that time there were several radio transmissions, however I could not make them out because there were all digital garble. At one point I heard some radio transmissions about Sandy Hook Elementary School regarding a shooting. After hearing that I attempted to contact dispatch to gather more information. When I called I could not get through, I would get a busy signal. I then went to the front of the School and continued to try and contact dispatch. A short time later I was able to speak with Dispatcher Nute who informed me there was a shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School. I asked if there was any information on suspects and he said there was possibly a second suspect at large but no description. I asked if I should respond and I was advised to remain at the High School. I then spoke to Assistant Principal Jason Hiruo and informed him of the incident. We then put the High School in lockdown. Myself and School staff then secured all outside doors to the School. I then went and blocked off the entrance and exit of the School with cones. I then returned to the lobby of the School and remained inside.

I responded to Sandy Hook Elementary School and I met with Lt. Vanghele I do not recall the time that I arrived at Sandy Hook Elementary School. Lt. Vanghele informed me the vehicle that was parked near the entrance to the School was believed to be the suspect's. I observed that vehicle which was a newer model Honda Civic. I observed the passenger side front and passenger side rear doors were both open. I also observed there were two black jackets or sweaters on the ground a short distance away from the vehicle. Lt. Vanghele informed me that the vehicle was registered to a person with the last name Lanza. I did not recognize the last name. Lt. Vanghele then asked if I would enter the scene to try and possibly identify the suspect. We then entered the school through the main entrance. We then went left down the hallway where I observed to deceased bodies. We then entered the classroom where the suspect was. I observed the suspect deceased. The suspect laying face down and slightly to his right side so most of his face was visible. I observed the suspect had an apparent gunshot wound to his head. I did not recognize the suspect. I then exited the school the same way I entered. I then checked the schools student database for the last name Lanza. There were no current students in the database with the last name Lanza.

I then remained outside and assisted Officers with securing the scene. I was near Ofc. Hull near the dumpsters when we heard some Officers in the woods yelling "show me your hands". Ofc. Hull and I then ran into the woods with our sidearm drawn, where several Connecticut Environmental Conservation Officers had two males at gunpoint. As I approached the males I observed they had several straps around their bodies with cameras

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on them with long lenses. The straps and the cameras with lenses made it appear they were holding weapons. The two men were patted down for weapons and none were found. I took the two men's identifications. One man had a Connecticut drivers license with OLN # [REDACTED] 04 . I contacted dispatch to perform a NCIC check. OLN # [REDACTED] 04 came back valid to a [REDACTED] 04, 03 . The second man had a New York drivers license with OLN [REDACTED] 04 . I had dispatch perform a NCIC check on that OLN. OLN # [REDACTED] came back valid to a [REDACTED] 04, 03 . The two males were asked what they were doing and they said they were reports and didn't realize they were entering the property of the school. We advised the two men that they were to leave the area immediately and if they returned they would be arrested.

After the two men had left I returned to the to the parking lot. I later reported to the Sandy Hook Fire House and worked with Chief Fuchs, Major Hyatt, and Ofc. Penna on preparing information on all the deceased victims."
