PURPOSE: Interview First Responders, responding to the Sandy Hook Elementary School murders

BACKGROUND: On Friday, December 14th, 2012, DEEP Officer Matthew Stone was on routine patrol in the Town of Woodbridge. At 0947 Hrs he received a call from dispatch of an active shooter at Sandy Hook Elementary School. Officer Stone responded lights and siren.

ACTION TAKEN: On Sunday, December 16th, 2012, at approximately 1200 Hrs, Detective Combes and I met with Officer Matthew Stone at the Detective Bureau, Newtown Police Department to conduct his interview. After conducting the interview, Officer Stone wrote and signed his sworn statement.

Officer Stone wrote the following statement: "On 12/14/12 at 0947 hours I was on routine patrol in Woodbridge Connecticut when I received a call from DEEP dispatch advising me of an active shooter at the Sandy Hook elementary school in the town of Newtown.

At 1019 hours I arrived at the school, parked in the main driveway to the school, and ran to the front of the school. On arrival at the front of the school Sergeant Dwyer #620 of the Connecticut Environmental Conservation Police asked me to take up a position on the north side of the school and stated the number of gunman is unknown and tactical teams were in the school searching.

I then ran to three green dumpsters at the northeast corner of the school and took up a position covering the north side of the school.

At approximately 1030 hours a tactical team opened a northeast door from within, pointed at me, and waved me over to them. I then ran to the school and entered through the door they had opened. I entered into an alcove in which I could see the kitchen and a door labeled Maintenance. One team member then asked me to hold a closet door open and cover him while he opened a locked door within the closet. The remainder of the team cleared the maintenance room. Once the closet and maintenance room were cleared the team leader asked me to stand by between the maintenance room and the kitchen area, while they continued their search of the school. I then held that position until relieved.

At approximately 1120 hours Sgt Dwyer #620 arrived at my position and relieved me of my post. I was then assigned to the hillside along the north side of the school.

At approximately 1440 hours Captain Camejo #689 of the Connecticut Environmental Conservation Police radioed all on scene officers that we were being relieved by Newtown Police and to meet for a debrief in the parking lot."
