Officer Figol responded to Sandy Hook School from a construction job in Newtown.

ACTION TAKEN:

On 12/14/12 at approximately 0945 hours, I met with Officer Figol within the Newtown Police Department. Prior to this meeting, Figol typed out her own written statement on a State Police form. I reviewed the statement and it was subsequently signed. Figol stated in a sworn written statement that she and Lt. Sinko were working a construction job with Brennan on Rt. 25 near Bear Hills Rd. At approximately 0930 hours, she was advised by dispatch of shots fired at Sandy Hook School. Figol does not remember the time but responded to the School with her K-9, Baro.

On scene, Figol observed two black shirts lying on the passenger side of a black Honda. The Honda's trunk was open and located within the trunk was a black long gun. Baro conducted a sniff of the shirts, which ultimately led Figol to the front doors of the school. Figol did not enter the school because the ESU team was conducting a sweep. Figol observed blood 03 12 lying on the ground near the front of the entrance along with several .223 casings. The glass to the front of the entrance was smashed.

Figol advised Sgt. Kullgren that Baro had tracked to the front of the school doors. Figol and Baro conducted exterior perimeter searches which no one was located. Figol then met up with other K-9 handlers to conduct further area searches. Officer Seabrook was used as Figol's backup. Figol searched the wooded area to the east of the school which led them to Treadwell Park. The buildings at the park were cleared with no one found.

Figol observed several classroom windows to the school with bullet holes in them as well as some of the vehicles parked in the lot (See attached written statement for details.)
