PURPOSE: Interview First Responders involved in the Sandy Hook Elementary School murders

BACKGROUND: On December 14th, 2012, Monroe K-9 Officer Bradshaw was at home at the time of the incident. He responded when he heard the news bulletin on the TV. 01 02

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ACTION TAKEN: On December 16th, 2013, at approximately 1730 Hrs, Detective Combes and I met with Officer Bradshaw at the Detective Bureau, Newtown Police Department to conduct his interview. After conducting the interview, Officer Bradshaw wrote and signed his sworn statement.

Officer Bradshaw made the following statement: "I am K-9 Officer Dennis Bradshaw with 15 year of service with the Monroe Police Department. On 12/14/12 while at home a news bulletin came across the TV saying that there had been a shooting at the Sandy Hook Elementary School 01 02 [REDACTED] I called Captain Flick of the Monroe requesting permission to respond to the scene. Permission was granted.

Once on scene I was told to park on the street across from the Sandy Hook Firehouse. I prepared my K-9 and head up the school driveway to meet with Newtown Officers. At the top of the driveway I observed two shot gun rounds under two vehicles parked in front of the school. I made a State trooper aware of the rounds. He checked the rounds and believed they had been racked by arriving officers. I then met with Newtown officers near the front of the school. I was assigned to set up K-9 units around the school. I stationed myself at the North East corner of the school. I then assigned the second Monroe K-9 unit at the South east corner. A State Trooper K-9 officer said he would take the South west corner of the school. When the Newtown K-9 officer arrived she took up the North West corner.

Approximately two and a half hours of being stationed at the perimitor 01 02 [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I then returned to the scene and met with the second Monroe K-9 unit to see if he needed to be relieved. He stated he was fine and did not want to leave. I then took the North east post State trooper could bring his vehicle to his area. Approximately a half hour later he returned. I then went to check on the Newtown k-9 officer when I was told to break down the k-9 units. At this point we took our k-9 units back to our vehicles and returned to the scene.

When we reached the front of the school, I observed a series of bullet hole in a window frame. I was with my second K-9 Officer and the Newtown K-9 Officer. We examined the bullet holes and while doing so I observed what I believed to be a child laying near a door way. I did not focus on the image because I still needed to focus at what needed to be done As I turned to my right I saw what I believed to children. At this point my other k-9 officer said he had just observed a child with a bullet wound 03, 12 I told him to focus on what needed to be done. I then went to the front doors of the school and saw that the young Newtown officer was still at his post signing officers coming and going. I asked him if he needed a break. He said that there was a State trooper coming to relieve him soon. As I was preparing to leave I observed a shadow in the left hallway of the school which I believed to be another body. On the ground in front of the shot out window I observed 5-6 .223 empty rounds. I also observed a trail of blood leading out of the school, and into the parking lot. I then met with Newtown officers at the North West area of the school. We stayed there

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waiting for assignment for approximately an hour. A Newtown LT approached us and said thank you for your help and that we could leave the scene and return to our departments.”
